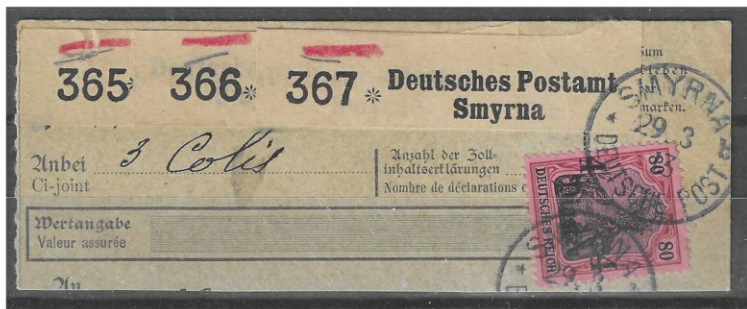

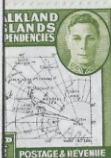

49 c1906-1913 United States Department of Agriculture INSPECTED MEAT tag No. G6921011, originally attached to inspected meat that had passed veterinarian inspection as fit for human consumption after the meat inspection act in 1906, printed James Wilson Secretary underneath, and patented 1863-1874 by Dennison's who produced these tags. Some faults on reverse, but remarkably survived in well above average condition. £ 35
