3) Karten dürfen 10 Seiten, nichtbilder dürfen als Postkarten nicht verwendet werden.
4) Gefangenen eine gestaltet; doch ist dabei Name und Vorname, Geburtsdatum, Hausnummer und Straße anzugeben.
5) Zettelungen sind gestattet, dürfen aber nur durch die Poststelle des K. L. Mauthausen gestattet werden.
6) Leih- und Hülfsbriefe sind gestattet. Außer wenn die Verzeichnisse und Belege vorhanden sind, werden Beschlagnahme.
7) Briefe sind ausschließlich aus der Schutzhaft an die Lagerleitung sind zwecklos.
8) Briefkasten und Besuche von Gefangenen in Konzentrationslager sind grundsätzlich gestattet.

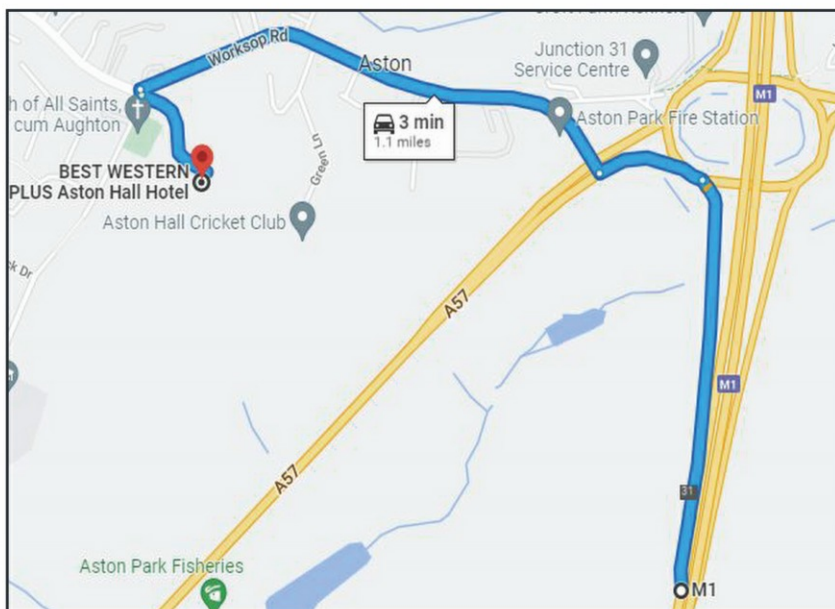

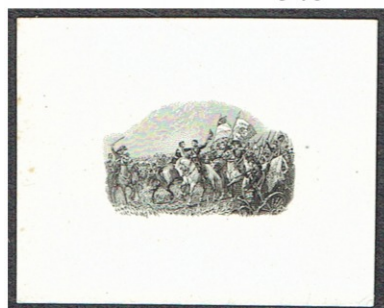
